The information you provide is essential for the Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA) to investigate the alleged damage incident. WSDA has investigated several of these types of cases in the past and has found that a large majority has been due to what we refer to as Atmospheric Deposition of pesticides. In these cases WSDA Investigators have documented physical symptoms of herbicide exposure to the vineyard. However, determining a responsible party is improbable because source of the herbicide causing the symptoms is unknown. The source could come from applications several miles away, including sources outside the State of Washington. Due to these circumstances WSDA cannot document any evidence of a violation of laws or rules. Therefore if you wish WSDA to conduct an official investigation on your report of loss, you must provide the information below and it must include; a drift pattern, a potential source of contamination, and must not be over 30 days old.
