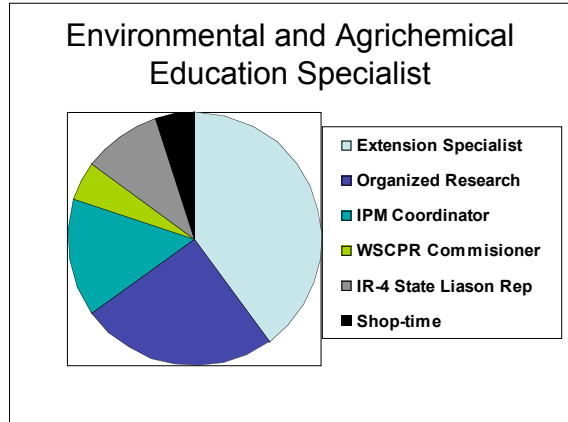

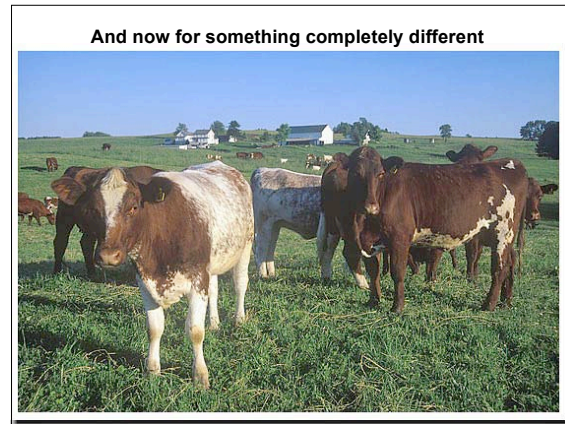

**Bean Count 2005**

- 55 Extension presentations
- Over 4,000 contact hours
- Over \$325,000 in extramural support
- 2 refereed articles (5 additional submitted)
- 1 extension bulletin
- 22 non-refereed technical publications
- 13 abstracts
- 6 commodity commission reports.

- *Entomological Society of America IPM Team Award (on poplars w/ J. Brown)*
- *Entomological Society of America Distinguished Achievement Award in Regulatory Entomology*

Pesticide reduction/ replacement as a result of my research and Extension efforts over the past several years

- Eliminated the use of chlorpyrifos on wine grapes and a 50% reduction in juice grapes (17,000 pounds/yr)
- Replaced diazinon on carrots with seed treatments (9,000 pounds/yr)
- Reduced the use of chlorpyrifos on poplars by 54,000 pounds (w/John Brown)
- New 24C for Novaluron will reduce the use of Naled by over 25,000 pounds per year on alfalfa grown for seed in Washington State
